Finding Rhythm

*For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven.

Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 & 11 (NLT)

FINDING GOD'S RHYTHM FOR MY LIFE

Start by looking for and understanding *IT*.

For everything there is a season (Chronos), a time (Kairos) for every activity... Ecclesiastes 3:1 (NLT)

I need to seek out, listen to, and trust the Conductor of it all.

Yet God *has made everything beautiful for its own time...*

Ecclesiastes 3:11 (NLT)

“Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.” **Matthew 11:28-30 (NIV)**

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. **James 1:5-6 (NIV)**

Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight. **Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV)**

Choose to live in the rhythm I am in.

So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do.

Ephesians 5:15-17 (NLT)

Going deeper on your own: Pastor Jay said, “God never told us to live life in balance rather, in rhythm.” Could you envision how living life in rhythm with God’s plans could lead to a less stressful life? Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 twice. Ask God to show you the rhythms that have already occurred in your life. Is there anything in your past you’ve taken on or pushed for that you did not need to do at that time? Now ask Him to reveal to you the rhythm, cycle, or situation you are in now and what He would encourage you to do or let go of. Write down your answers, and then choose what you will or won’t allow and do in this season and time in your life. Trust Him with the results.
