

GOD'S LAST WORD (Final Instruction) – Revelation 22:8-21

HOW DO I LIVE IN TIMES LIKE THESE? LISTEN TO GOD'S FINAL INSTRUCTION.

1. Never allow anyone, or anything, to come between the Lord and me.

... "No, don't worship me. I am a servant of God, just like you and your brothers the prophets, as well as all who obey what is written in this book. **Worship only God!**" **Revelations 22:9 (NLT)**

2. Continue to grow to become more and more like Jesus.

"Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city."

Revelation 22:14 (NIV)

3. Know, live by, and speak nothing but (and only) THE TRUTH.

*The Spirit and the bride say, "Come." Let anyone who hears this say, "Come." Let anyone who is thirsty come. Let anyone who desires drink freely from the water of life. And I solemnly declare to everyone who hears the words of prophecy written in this book: If anyone adds anything to what is written here, God will add to that person the plagues described in this book. And if anyone removes any of the words from this book of prophecy, God will remove that person's share in the tree of life and in the holy city that are described in this book. **Revelation 22:17-19 (NLT)***

*He who is the faithful witness to all these things says, "Yes, I am coming soon!" **Revelation 22:20 (NLT)***

Going deeper on your own: Read Revelation 22:7-21. Ask yourself, is there anything I have placed before Christ in my life? If so, confess it and rededicate yourself to His Lordship. Pray and ask the Lord to reveal anything you have compromised on regarding His truth based on cultural influences. As He reveals it, ask for forgiveness and recommit yourself to His truth on that matter. Read Hebrews 12:1-2. Based upon what the future will hold, what should you do to prepare for it? Make a list of the weights holding you back from living the life Christ wants you to live. Christ can set you free from those issues if you give them to Him. Make a specific list of the things you want to get rid of in your life, such as addiction, infidelity, a wrong relationship, etc. Pray about it and post the list somewhere you can review it regularly. Each time you review it, pray about it. As Christ begins removing things from your life, scratch it off the list.
