## A STEWARDSHIP OF GENEROSITY

*I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.*

**Romans 12:1-2 (ESV)**

**God is the owner of it all.**

## STEWARDSHIP OF GENEROSITY

It is an investment of:

### Time

*Look carefully then how you walk, not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Therefore, do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is.*

**Ephesians 5:15-17 (ESV)**

### Talents

*"For it will be like a man going on a journey, who called his servants and entrusted to them his property. To one he gave five talents, to another two, to another one, to each according to his ability. Then he went away."* **Matthew 25:14-15 (ESV)**

### Treasure

*"Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much. So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches? And if you have not been trustworthy with someone else's property, who will give you property of your own?"* **Luke 16:10-11 (NIV)**

**Plan to be generous.**

*But generous people plan to do what is generous, and they stand firm in their generosity.* **Isaiah 32:8 (ESV)**

**Going deeper on your own:** A lifestyle that lives by stewardship of generosity must *plan* to do so. Being generous does not happen by accident. We must plan, develop a habit of generosity, and prepare our lives to align with God's will for our lives. I would encourage you to do a deep dive this week regarding your generosity. Ask yourself, "Do I have margin in my life with the resources of time, talents, and treasures?" Evaluate how you spend your time, talents, and treasures.
