LISTEN TO THE MUSIC

Worship—To *love* and be *loved*.

...Because of His love, God had already decided that through Jesus Christ He would make us His children – this was His pleasure and purpose.
Ephesians 1:4-5 (GNT)

I was made to worship. (To give love away!)

To worship (to love) is not merely a part of my life; it is the essence of my life.

Jesus said, *“Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind’...”* **Lk. 10:27 (NIV)**

...worship (love) him continually... **Psalms 105:4 (GNT)**

Praise Him from sunrise to sunset! **Psalms 113:3 (TLB)**

But an hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for such people the Father seeks to be His worshipers. **John 4:23 (NASB)**

HOW TO LOVE (WORSHIP) THE GOD WHO LOVES ME

1. I must intentionally choose to put God first above and before every relationship, situation, and circumstance that makes up my life.

“You shall have no other gods before Me.” Deuteronomy 5:7 (NIV)

...for you shall not worship (love) any other god (person, place, or thing before God), for the Lord, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God. Exodus 34:14 (ESV)

2. I must practically practice loving Him first.
(Worship Him continually.)

*...Take your everyday, ordinary life – your sleeping, eating, going to work, and walking around life – and **place it before God as an offering**... Romans 12:1 (MSG)*

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not human masters... Colossians 3:23 (NIV)

So whether you eat or drink or whatever you do, do it all for the glory of God. 1 Corinthians 10:31 (NIV)

3. I should regularly worship (love) Him with His family. (Worship Him with others.)

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another... Hebrews 10:25 (NLT)

Jesus said, “For where two or three are gathered in my name, there am I among them.” Matthew 18:20 (ESV)
