## LISTEN TO THE MUSIC

A Lifestyle of Loving and Worshiping God Well

### HOW TO BUILD AN INTIMATE LIFESTYLE OF LOVING AND BEING LOVED BY GOD

**1. Choose to glorify God in every circumstance and situation.**

*Every time I think of you, I give thanks to my God. Philippians 1:3 (NLT)*

*May you always be filled with the fruit of your salvation—the righteous character produced in your life by Jesus Christ—for this will bring much **glory and praise to God.** Philippians 1:11 (NLT)*

*But that doesn't matter. Whether their motives are false or genuine, **the message about Christ (the Goodness and Glory of God) is being preached either way, so I rejoice. And I will continue to rejoice.***

**Philippians 1:18 (NLT)**

## 2. Practice praising and loving God in all circumstances.

***Rejoice always, pray continually, give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (NIV)***

*We can rejoice, too, when we run into problems and trials, for we know that they help us develop endurance. And endurance develops strength of character, and character strengthens our confident hope of salvation. And this hope will not lead to disappointment. For we know how dearly God loves us, because He has given us the Holy Spirit to fill our hearts with His love. Romans 5:3-5 (NLT)*

## 3. Stick close to other worshippers. (Never go it alone.)

***Every time I think of you, I give thanks to my God. Philippians 1:3 (NLT)***

***We are in this struggle together... Philippians 1:30 (NLT)***

*Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep His promise. Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.*

**Hebrews 10:23-25 (NLT)**
