How To Let The Fire Burn

*One day Moses was tending the flock of his father-in-law, Jethro, the priest of Midian. He led the flock far into the wilderness and came to Sinai, the mountain of God (Horeb/Sinai). There the angel of the Lord appeared to him in a blazing fire from the middle of a bush. Moses stared in amazement. Though the bush was engulfed in flames, it didn't burn up. "This is amazing," Moses said to himself. "Why isn't that bush burning up? **I must go see it.**" When the Lord saw Moses coming to take a closer look, God called to him from the middle of the bush, "Moses! Moses!" "Here I am!" Moses replied. "Do not come any closer," the Lord warned. "Take off your sandals, for you are standing on holy ground. I am the God of your father—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob." When Moses heard this, he covered his face because he was afraid to look at God. Then the Lord told him, "I have certainly seen the oppression of my people in Egypt. I have heard their cries of distress because of their harsh slave drivers. Yes, I am aware of their suffering. So I have come down to rescue them from the power of the Egyptians and lead them out of Egypt into their own fertile and spacious land. It is a land flowing with milk and honey—the land where the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites, and Jebusites now live. Look! The cry of the people of Israel has reached me, and I have seen how harshly the Egyptians abuse them. Now go, for I am sending you to Pharaoh. You must lead my people Israel out of Egypt." But Moses protested to God, "Who am I to appear before Pharaoh? Who am I to lead the people of Israel out of Egypt?" **Exodus 3:1-11 (NLT)***

God answered, "I will be with you. And this is your sign that I am the one who has sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you will worship God at this very mountain." But Moses protested, "If I go to the people of Israel and tell them, 'The God of your ancestors has sent me to you,' they will ask me, 'What is His name?' Then what should I tell them?" God replied to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. Say this to the people of Israel: I AM has sent me to you." Exodus 3:12-14 (NLT)

HOW TO KEEP THE FIRE BURNING

1. I must remember God is never changing, and always present.

...Though the bush was engulfed in flames, it didn't burn up. v. 2

...I AM WHO I AM... v. 14

2. I must look for and turn to Him every day!

"...I must go see it." v. 3

So I have come down to rescue... v. 8

3. I must listen for, and to, His voice.

When the Lord saw Moses coming to take a closer look, God called to him from the middle of the bush, "Moses! Moses!" "Here I am!" Moses replied. v. 4

4. I must worship Him in obedience. (Just do it!)

Now go, for I am sending you... v. 10

..."I will be with you. And this is your sign... you will worship God at this very mountain." v. 12

Going deeper on your own: Review today's message notes, then look up and read the following verses out loud: Jeremiah 29:13, Matthew 1:23 & 28:20, Hebrews 13:15, & Matthew 11:28. Pastor Jay made the statement, "I have never found anyone that I wasn't looking for." When was the last time you *truly looked* for God in the everyday walk of life? This week pray and ask God to reveal Himself in your life. When He does, intentionally turn away from the menial tasks of the day, ask Him to reveal what He desires for you to do, then just do it!
