HOW TO HEAL ANGER-DAMAGED RELATIONSHIPS

Jesus said, *“God blesses those who are merciful, for they will be shown mercy.”* **Matthew 5:7 (NLT)**

HOW TO HEAL AND REBUILD A DAMAGED RELATIONSHIP

(Lessons from Jesus Christ and Peter)

1. Understand this is God’s desire for me.

Jesus appeared again to the disciples... John 21:1 (NLT)

*If it is possible, **as far as it depends on you**, live at peace with everyone.*
Romans 12:18 (NIV)

2. Use the Jesus model:

a. Intentionally plan your moment.

*Jesus appeared again to the disciples, **by the Sea of Galilee...***
John 21:1 (NLT)

b. Begin by blessing them. (Discover and meet their needs.)

He called out, “Fellows, have you caught any fish?” “No,” they replied. Then He said, “Throw out your net on the right-hand side of the boat, and you’ll get some!”... vv. 5-6

When they got there, they found breakfast waiting for them—fish cooking over a charcoal fire, and some bread. vv. 9

c. Focus on the issue that caused the damage, not the individual.

A third time He asked him, “Simon son of John, do you love me?” vv. 17a

d. Seek and offer forgiveness.

Peter was hurt that Jesus asked the question a third time. He said, “Lord, you know everything. You know that I love you.” Jesus said, “Then feed my sheep.” vv. 17b

e. Agree to let the past be the past and focus on a new future.

“Follow me.” vv.19b

Going deeper on your own: In today’s message Pastor Jay said, “Anger and love cannot inhabit the same space.” Do you agree or disagree? He also said, “To be healers, peacemakers, and rebuilders of relationships is our responsibility, our calling, and our mission.” Do you agree or disagree? Read John 21:1-19. Pray, place it before the Lord, listen, then take a risk on God and go for it.
