The Road To Healing

God uses others to alleviate our fears and give us comfort.

Elijah was afraid and ran for his life. When he came to Beersheba in Judah, he left his servant there, while he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness. He came to a broom bush, sat down under it and prayed that he might die. **1 Kings 19:3 (NIV)**

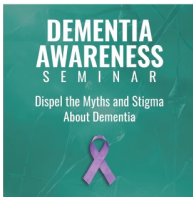
Discover CPC
