### HOW TO HELP THOSE STRUGGLING WITH MENTAL ILLNESS

A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity.

**Proverbs 17:17 (ESV)**

### HOW TO HELP THOSE WHO ARE BATTLING MIND GAMES

#### 1. Choose to care.

Again He said, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you." **John 20:21 (NLT)**

*A caretaker's prayer: Oh, Heavenly Father, I am not good at this. I don't know what to do. So now I ask you to give me great patience and deep compassion and show me how I can help. I place my life in your hands to help this person. Thank you, and Amen.*

#### 2. Seek to understand. (Listen and pray for God's wisdom and understanding.)

If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and He will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. **James 1:5 (NLT)**

For by wise guidance you can wage your war, and in abundance of counselors there is victory. **Proverbs 24:6 (ESV)**

*A caretaker's prayer: God, I have so many questions, so few answers. Yet now I ask you to unveil the hidden things so that I might understand. Lead me into the pathways of your servants who can bring me understanding so that I might be your instrument of healing. Thank you, and Amen.*

### **3. Get help for the whole person. (Mind, Body, and Spirit)**

...While He (Jesus) was preaching God's word to them, four men arrived carrying a paralyzed man on a mat. ...they dug a hole through the roof above His head. Then they lowered the man on his mat, right down in front of Jesus. Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the paralyzed man, "My child, your sins are forgiven." **Mark 2:2-5 (NLT)**

*The caretaker's prayer: Oh, Heavenly Father, I often don't know what to do, but now I ask you to show me how to get help for those who are hurting. Give me the courage to get help for those in need and support them on their journey. Thank you, and Amen.*

### **4. Constantly speak God's truth into the brokenness.**

But Jesus told him, "No! The Scriptures say, 'People do not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'" **Matthew 4:4 (NLT)**

For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me, and I will hear you. You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart. **Jer. 29:11-13 (ESV)**

*The caretaker's prayer: Oh, Heavenly Father, today let everything coming out of my mouth bring life and truth. Fill my mind with your truth today that I may plant it in the mind of everyone I come in contact with. Use my mouth to convey your truth and life to the one who is hurting. Thank you, and Amen.*

**Going deeper on your own:** Review today's message notes. Pray asking God to reveal to you someone who made need help. Read the four caretaker's prayers. Insert the name of that person in the prayer, then as the Lord answers your prayer, lean in and choose to be God's answer to their need. 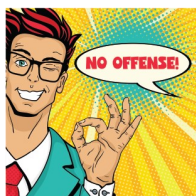
