CPC's response to unplanned pregnancy:

FINDING HOPE - *Hope And Help For Unplanned Pregnancy*

Mission Statement: *Finding Hope exists to offer hope and help to expectant Moms, their families, and their unborn babies.*

God's take on unplanned pregnancy:

Genesis 21:14-19 (NLT) | ¹⁴So Abraham got up early the next morning, prepared food and a container of water, and strapped them on Hagar's shoulders. Then he sent her away with their son, and she wandered aimlessly in the wilderness of Beersheba. ¹⁵When the water was gone, she put the boy in the shade of a bush. ¹⁶Then she went and sat down by herself about a hundred yards away. "I don't want to watch the boy die," she said, as she burst into tears. ¹⁷But God heard the boy crying, and the angel of God called to Hagar from heaven, "Hagar, what's wrong? Do not be afraid! God has heard the boy crying as he lies there. ¹⁸Go to him and comfort him, for I will make a great nation from his descendants." ¹⁹Then God opened Hagar's eyes, and she saw a well full of water. She quickly filled her water container and gave the boy a drink.

Big Idea: Compassion is not a slogan to proclaim its calling to exercise.

How To Bring Compassion To Those Facing An Unplanned Pregnancy

1. Choose to be Pro-Love over Pro-Loud. (Create a quiet space.)

Genesis 21:17 (NLT) | ¹⁷But God heard the boy crying, and the angel of God called to Hagar from heaven, “Hagar, what’s wrong? Do not be afraid! God has heard the boy crying as he lies there.”

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 & 13 (NLT) | Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud⁵ or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged.⁶ It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out.⁷ Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance...¹³Three things will last forever—faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love.

2. Choose Pro-Love over just being Pro-Life. (Step in.)

Genesis 21:18 (NLT) | ¹⁸“Go to him and comfort him, for I will make a great nation from his descendants.”

3. Choose Pro-Love over just Pro-Birth. (Step into the story.)

Genesis 21:19 (NLT) | ¹⁹Then God opened Hagar’s eyes, and she saw a well full of water. She quickly filled her water container and gave the boy a drink.

Going deeper on your own: Pastor Jay said, “If we claim we are pro-life yet offer no physical or tangible support to those facing unplanned pregnancies, then are we as pro-life as we claim?” He also said, “Pro-life is proven just as much after the birth of a child as it is leading up to it.” There are always three lives involved in an unplanned pregnancy, not just one. Unfortunately, it is often only the one that gets our attention and effort. Pray and ask the Lord to help you see those facing unplanned pregnancies as He does. Ask Him to place you in a position to assist someone who may need help with an unplanned pregnancy. **NEXT STEP: Pick up two Finding Hope ministry cards and hand them out to those needing them. This week, buy a package of diapers or wipes and drop them off in the Finding Hope ministry collection bin next week.**

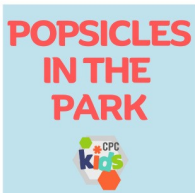
