Big idea: Move from talking about pro-love/life to being pro-love/life.

HOW TO BE PRO-LOVE OVER JUST PRO-LIFE - BECOME AN INSTRUMENT OF HOPE

1. Start by comforting first.

John 8:3-7 & 9-11 (NLT) | As He was speaking, the teachers of religious law and the Pharisees brought a woman who had been caught in the act of adultery. They put her in front of the crowd. "Teacher," they said to Jesus, "this woman was caught in the act of adultery. ⁵The law of Moses says to

stone her. What do you say?" They were trying to trap him into saying something they could use against him, but Jesus stooped down and wrote in the dust with his finger. ⁷They kept demanding an answer, so he stood up again and said, "All right, but let the one who has never sinned throw the first stone!"... ⁹When the accusers heard this, they slipped away one by one, beginning with the oldest, until only Jesus was left in the middle of the crowd with the woman. ¹⁰Then Jesus stood up again and said to the woman, "Where are your accusers? Didn't even one of them condemn you?" ¹¹"No, Lord," she said. And Jesus said, "Neither do I..."

2. Meet the first immediate need. (Be tangible in the moment.)

John 8:7&10-11 (NLT) | ...but let the one who has never sinned throw the first stone!"... "Where are your accusers? Didn't even one of them condemn you?" ¹¹"No, Lord," she said. And Jesus said, "Neither do I..."

3. Lovingly connect them with His support team.

Luke 8:1-3 (NLT) | Soon afterward Jesus began a tour of the nearby towns and villages, preaching and announcing the Good News about the Kingdom of God. He took his twelve disciples with him, ²along with some women who had been cured of evil spirits and diseases. Among them were Mary Magdalene, from whom he had cast out seven demons; ³Joanna, the wife of Chuza, Herod's business manager; Susanna; and many others who were contributing from their own resources to support Jesus and his disciples.

4. Make space in your life and include them in it. (Become a Para-Parent.)

James 1:27 (NIV) | "Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world."

Mathew 12:48-50 (NLT) | Jesus asked, "Who is my mother? Who are my brothers?" Then he pointed to his disciples and said, "Look, these are my mother and brothers. Anyone who does the will of my Father in heaven is my brother and sister and mother!"

Going deeper on your own. In this week's message Pastor Jay made the statement, "Quit worrying about what you can't do and just start doing what you can." Do you see the freedom to make a difference in that statement? He also stated, "No one can do everything, except God, so why don't you introduce those in need to Him?"
