The Tribe We Value – The Church

Hebrews 2:10 NCV | God is the One who made all things, and all things are for His glory. He wanted to have many children share His glory.

1 John 3:1 NLT | See how very much our Father loves us, for He calls us His children, and that is what we are!...

We value community - God's community, The Church.

The Church is God's Family, His Tribe.

1 Timothy 3:15 GWT | ...God's family (Tribe) is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of truth.

Ephesians 1:4-5 NLB | Long ago, even before He made the world, God loved us and chose us...to adopt us into His own family (Tribe) by bringing us to Himself through Jesus Christ.

Romans 12:5 NIV | ...in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.

Matthew 16:18 NLT | Jesus said, "...I will build my church (My Tribe), and all the powers of hell will not conquer it."

Ephesians 5:25 NIRV | ...Christ loved the church. He gave Himself up for her.

Big Idea: Help create the community God has always hoped for.

Why don't people value God's church?

Because they have never seen one or because they have. (John 13:34-35 NLT)

Why they should:

It's where God's hope and help is found. (Acts 2:42-47 & Ephesians 4:16)

Why we do:

Because we love what God loves. (Ephesians 5:25)

How we value community: By creating a SAFFE place for it.

Sanctuary for the hurting and downtrodden. (1 Corinthians 9:19-23 & Acts 2:42-47)

Acceptance for people no matter where they are regarding a relationship with God, whether far or intimate. (Romans 15:7)

Forgiveness for those who are seeking it from our God. (Ephesians 4:23)

Freedom from past mistakes. As Christ forgives the past, so do we. (Colossians 3:13)

Encouragement where people come and regularly get lifted up. (1 Thessalonians 5:11)

Going deeper on your own: Pastor Jay talked about the transfer portal for college athletics in this week's message. If a scholarship athlete does not like how things are going, they transfer to another school. He said, "Today's college athlete uses the schools but doesn't *love* them." He also said, "It's sad, but many Christ followers do the same thing with their team. They use the church but don't love it." Can you see how that could happen? Read Acts 2:41-47 and Ephesians 5:25-27. **Next Step: Join the team, put on the colors, and fill your role in God's family.**
