Genesis 6:8 | ⁸ But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord.

BIG IDEA: Faithful obedience leads to the full experience of God's promise.

Genesis 6:9-14 | ⁹ This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God. ¹⁰ Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth. ¹¹ Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and was full of violence. ¹² God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on the earth had corrupted their ways. ¹³ So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all the people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth. ¹⁴ So make for yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out.

1. We are called to live fearlessly faithful in the eyes of God and humanity.

Genesis 6:18-22 | ¹⁸ But I will establish my covenant with you, and you will enter the ark – you and your sons and your wife and your sons’ wives with you. ¹⁹ You are to bring in to the ark two of all living creatures, male and female, to keep them alive with you. ²⁰ Two of every kind of bird, of every kind of animal and of every kind of creature that moves along the ground will come to you to be kept alive. ²¹ You are to take every kind of food that is to be eaten and store it away as food for you and for them. ²² Noah did everything just as God commanded him.

2. A covenant has mutual responsibility on both sides of the promise.

Genesis 7:5 | ⁵ And Noah did all that the Lord commanded him.

3. The storm won’t last forever. God remembers you.

Genesis 8:1 | But God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and the livestock that were with him in the ark, and he sent a wind over the earth, and the waters receded.

4. Faith leads me forward even when I can’t see what’s next.

Hebrews 11:7 | ⁷ By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear built an ark to save his family. By his faith he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness that is in keeping with faith.

Going deeper on your own: Read Genesis 6-9.

- Was there anything that stood out to you that you hadn’t noticed before?
- Is there a time that God brought you through what seemed to be an impossible situation? How did that build your faith?
