## Reruns | Finding Plan B?

Lessons from Naomi

**Romans 8:28 NLT** | And we know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them.

**Hebrews 11:6 NLT** | And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to Him must believe that God exists and that He rewards those who sincerely seek Him.

**BIG IDEA:** Loving God with our trust, is the greatest gift we can give Him and ourselves.

### HOW TO FIND GOD'S PLAN A

1. **Remember**, God is faithful to the **faith-filled**.

**Hebrews 11:6 NLT** | And it is impossible to please God without faith... He rewards those who sincerely seek Him.

2. Get **real** with the **real** God, He can handle it.

**Ruth 1:20-21 NIV** | "Don't call me Naomi," she told them. "Call me Mara, because the Almighty has made my life very bitter. I went away full, but the Lord has brought me back empty..."

### 3. Look for how He is working and take Him up on it!

**Ruth 1:16-18 (NIV)** | But Ruth replied, “Don’t urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. Your people will be my people and your God my God. Where you die I will die, and there I will be buried. May the Lord deal with me, be it ever so severely, if even death separates you and me.” When Naomi realized that Ruth was determined to go with her, she stopped urging her.

**Ruth 1:19 NLT** | ...When they came to Bethlehem, the entire town was excited by their arrival. “Is it really Naomi?”

### 4. As God provides a new direction, take it.

**Ruth 2:11-23 NIV (paraphrased)** | Boaz replied, “I’ve been told all about what you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband... May the Lord repay you for what you have done. May you be richly rewarded by the Lord, the God of Israel, under whose wings you have come to take refuge.” Naomi found out about Boaz, “The Lord bless him!” Naomi said to her daughter-in-law. “He has not stopped showing His kindness to the living and the dead.” She added, “That man is our close relative; he is one of our guardian-redeemers.” Then Ruth the Moabite said, “He even said to me, ‘Stay with my workers until they finish harvesting all my grain.’” Naomi said to Ruth her daughter-in-law, “It will be good for you, my daughter, to go with the women who work for him, because in someone else’s field you might be harmed.” So Ruth stayed close to the women of Boaz to glean until the barley and wheat harvests were finished. And she lived with her mother-in-law.

**Going deeper on your own:** Has anything happened in your life that you never saw coming? How has it affected your life? Read the book of Ruth this week and answer the following questions: How would you react if you absolutely knew God was with you in every situation? Why do you think it is so hard to imagine that God is with us when we’re in a Plan B situation? Have you ever been tempted to place your faith in what God does instead of who He is? Pastor Jay said, “To worship God with our trust is the greatest gift you could give Him and ourselves.” Would you agree or disagree? **NEXT STEPS:** Seek out someone you trust and tell them a dream/hope/plan that you may be struggling with. Ask them to pray that God would help you see His plan. Then tell them about it and ask them to encourage you as you move to where He wants you to go. Write Pastor Jay and tell him your story.
