## Reruns | From The Pit To The Palace

Genesis 37-50

**Philippians 1:6 NLT** | And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue His work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns.

**Hebrews 10:23 NLT** | Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted...

**BIG IDEA: GOD NEVER QUITS ON HIS CHILD, HIS FAMILY, OR HIS PLAN.**

**HOW TO TURN A SETBACK INTO A STEP FORWARD**

**1. Remember, God is with us in the pit, the prison, and the palace.**

**Genesis 45:4 NIV** | Then Joseph said to his brothers, "Come close to me." When they had done so, he said, "I am your brother Joseph, the one you sold into Egypt! <sup>5</sup>And now, do not be distressed and do not be angry with yourselves for selling me here, because it was to save lives that **God sent me ahead of you**.

**2. Intentionally kill the pride before it kills you.**

**Genesis 37:5-8 NLT** | <sup>5</sup>One night Joseph had a dream, and when he told his brothers about it, they hated him more than ever. <sup>6</sup>"Listen to this dream," he said.

<sup>7</sup> “We were out in the field, tying up bundles of grain. Suddenly my bundle stood up, and your bundles all gathered around and bowed low before mine!” <sup>8</sup> His brothers responded, “So you think you will be our king, do you? Do you actually think you will reign over us?” And they hated him all the more because of his dreams and the way he talked about them.

**1 John 2:16 NIV** | For everything in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—comes not from the Father but from the world.

### **3. Embrace the space God has me in. (Pray, listen, and live with integrity.)**

**Genesis 39:2-4 NIV** | <sup>2</sup> The Lord was with Joseph so that he prospered, and he lived in the house of his Egyptian master. <sup>3</sup> When his master saw that the Lord was with him and that the Lord gave him success in everything he did, <sup>4</sup> Joseph found favor in his eyes and became his attendant. Potiphar put him in charge of his household, and he entrusted to his care everything he owned.

**Genesis 39:20-21 NIV** | <sup>20</sup> Joseph’s master took him and put him in prison, the place where the king’s prisoners were confined. But while Joseph was there in the prison, <sup>21</sup> the Lord was with him; He showed him kindness and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden.

**Genesis 41:38 NLT** | So Pharaoh asked his officials, “Can WE find anyone else like this man so obviously filled with the spirit of God?”

### **4. Start living for the good of others and God’s glory.**

**Genesis 50:19-20** | <sup>19</sup> But Joseph said to them, “Don’t be afraid. Am I in the place of God? <sup>20</sup> You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives.”

**Going deeper on your own:** When facing a setback, embrace the space you’re in by turning it into Holy Ground. Praise God. Pray and listen for Him to speak. Live with integrity wherever you are and whoever you’re with. **NEXT STEP:** Read the amazing story of Joseph found in Genesis 37-50. Find courage and hope in the truth that there is no place you can go that God is not. He is always interested in His plans for your life.
