EXODUS – THE BIG EXIT

Exodus 3:7-8 NLT | Then the Lord told him, “I have certainly seen the oppression of my people in Egypt. I have heard their cries of distress because of their harsh slave drivers. Yes, I am aware of their suffering. ⁸So I have come down to rescue them from the power of the Egyptians and lead them out of Egypt into their own fertile and spacious land. It is a land flowing with milk and honey...”

Isaiah 59:1 NLT | Listen! The Lord’s arm is not too weak to save you, nor is His ear too deaf to hear you call.

BIG IDEA: God will make a way. Our part: Pray, listen, and walk it.

FINDING GOD’S WAY

1. Recognize that GOD’S WAY may not be the obvious or the easiest, but you can trust it will be revealed and be the best.

Exodus 13:17-18 NLT | ¹⁷When Pharaoh finally let the people go, God did not lead them along the main road that runs through Philistine territory, even though that was the shortest route to the Promised Land. God said, “If the people are faced with a battle, they might change their minds and return to Egypt.” ¹⁸So God led them in a roundabout way through the wilderness toward the Red Sea. Thus the Israelites left Egypt like an army ready for battle.

2. Recognize fear keeps me stagnant. Faith keeps me steady.

Exodus 14:10-16 NLT | ¹⁰ As Pharaoh approached, the people of Israel looked up and panicked when they saw the Egyptians overtaking them. They cried out to the Lord, ¹¹ and they said to Moses, “Why did you bring us out here to die in the wilderness? Weren’t there enough graves for us in Egypt? What have you done to us? Why did you make us leave Egypt? ¹² Didn’t we tell you this would happen while we were still in Egypt? We said, ‘Leave us alone! Let us be slaves to the Egyptians. It’s better to be a slave in Egypt than a corpse in the wilderness!’” ¹³ But Moses told the people, “Don’t be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today. The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. ¹⁴ The Lord Himself will fight for you. Just stay calm.” ¹⁵ Then the Lord said to Moses, “Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to get moving! ¹⁶ Pick up your staff and raise your hand over the sea. Divide the water so the Israelites can walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground.”

3. Remember, THE WAY belongs to the Lord. Give God the floor.

Exodus 14:13-14 NLT | But Moses told the people, “Don’t be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today. The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. ¹⁴ The Lord Himself will fight for you. Just stay calm.”

4. Keep moving forward with God.

Exodus 14:15-16 NLT | Then the Lord said to Moses, “Why are you crying out to me? Tell the people to get moving! ¹⁶ Pick up your staff and raise your hand over the sea. Divide the water so the Israelites can walk through the middle of the sea on dry ground.”

Going deeper on your own: God often speaks to us in the desert moments of our lives. Are we looking for the burning bush? Are we expecting God to speak to us?

NEXT STEPS: Read the rest of Moses’ story found in Exodus 1-14. As you read through these moments, note the number of times that God reveals *His* way. Make notes of Jeremiah 29:11-13, Proverbs 3:5-6, and Psalm 37:23 as reminders throughout the week that God will show you the way.

Summer Midweek Bible Study

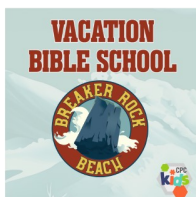
