Reruns | The Walls Came Tumbling Down

BIG IDEA: When it seems impossible, remain faithful and the walls will fall.

Joshua 1:5-6 NIV | ⁵“No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. ⁶Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.”

Joshua 5:13-15 NIV | ¹³ Now when Joshua was near Jericho, he looked up and saw a man standing in front of him with a drawn sword in his hand. Joshua went up to him and asked, “Are you for us or for our enemies?” ¹⁴ “Neither,” he replied, “but as commander of the army of the Lord I have now come.” Then Joshua fell facedown to the ground in reverence, and asked him, “What message does my Lord have for his servant?” ¹⁵ The commander of the Lord’s army replied, “Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy.” And Joshua did so.

1. **Worship and submission are the only appropriate responses to the presence of God.**

Joshua 6:1-5 NIV | ¹ Now the gates of Jericho were securely barred because of the Israelites. No one went out and no one came in. ² Then the Lord said to Joshua, “See, I have delivered Jericho into your hands, along with its king and its fighting men. ³ March around the city once with all the armed men. Do this for six days. ⁴ Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams’ horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets. ⁵ When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse and the army will go up, everyone straight in.”

2. Worship is an effective strategy for tearing down walls.

Joshua 6:15-16, 20 NIV | ¹⁵ On the seventh day, they got up at daybreak and marched around the city seven times in the same manner, except that on that day they circled the city seven times. ¹⁶ The seventh time around, when the priests sounded the trumpet blast, Joshua commanded the army, “Shout! For the Lord has given you the city!” ...²⁰ When the trumpets sounded, the army shouted, and at the sound of the trumpet, when the men gave a loud shout, the wall collapsed; so everyone charged straight in, and they took the city.

3. Consistent obedience in the small things leads to extraordinary results.

4. Live each day with a spirit of expectancy.

NEXT STEP: Read the rest of the story in Joshua 1-6, and let your strength and courage grow.

Going deeper on your own: Read Joshua 4:1-7. God has done incredible things in our lives and in the lives of those that we know and care for. When God does amazing things, we should make physical or mental markers that will allow us to remember what God did, how He delivered, and how we felt in those moments. Looking back on what God has done and how far He has brought us builds our faith to move forward.

What are some great things God has done? What mental or physical markers do you have to remember those so your faith can grow stronger and more courageous?
