Proverbs 20:7 NLT | The Godly walk with integrity; blessed are their children who follow them.

BIG IDEA: God rewards the faithfully obedient.

Genesis 6:9 NLT | This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time, and he walked in close fellowship with God.

Genesis 6:12-14 NIV | God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on the earth had corrupted their ways. ¹³ So God said to Noah, “I am going to put an end to all the people... ¹⁴ So make for yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out.

Genesis 8:15-21 NLT | Then God said to Noah, ¹⁶ “Leave the boat, all of you—you and your wife, and your sons and their wives. ¹⁷ Release all the animals—the birds, the livestock, and the small animals that scurry along the ground—so they can be fruitful and multiply throughout the earth.” ¹⁸ So Noah, his wife, and his sons and their wives left the boat. ¹⁹ And all of the large and small animals and birds came out of the boat, pair by pair...

²⁰Then Noah built an altar to the Lord, and there he sacrificed as burnt offerings the animals and birds that had been approved for that purpose. ²¹And the Lord was pleased with the aroma of the sacrifice and said to Himself, "I will never again curse the ground because of the human race, even though everything they think or imagine is bent toward evil from childhood..."

Genesis 9:1 NLT | Then God blessed Noah and his sons and told them, "Be fruitful and multiply. Fill the earth..."

Genesis 9:12-13 NLT | Then God said, "I am giving you a sign of my covenant with you and with all living creatures, for all generations to come. ¹³I have placed my rainbow in the clouds..."

HOW TO BE THE MAN

1. Choose who we will follow regardless of who will follow us. (Genesis 6:5-9, Proverbs 20:7)
2. Lead based upon God's direction, not culture's waves. (Genesis 6:1-9)
3. Rest knowing God is working in the obedience. (Genesis 6:17-18, 22, & 8:1)
4. Run through the finish line, not merely to it. (Genesis 8:20-21)
5. Do my best and trust God with the rest. (Genesis 9:1-13)

Going deeper on your own: Read Genesis 6-9 again. This time, think about it through the eyes of a husband and father. Think about it through the eyes of a wife and children. What do you think Noah's wife and children thought about Noah and this endeavor as he was building the Ark? What do you think they thought about Noah and God after the endeavor was over? **NEXT STEPS:** Make up your mind, draw a line in the sand, and choose to live your life in obedience to the one true God. In doing so, tell your family, and then lead.
