Crushing It | Living for More Than Good Enough

John 10:10 NIV | (Jesus Christ said) “The thief (the god of this world/Satan) comes only to steal and kill and destroy; **I have come that they may have life and have it to the full.**”

Romans 8:31 & 37 NLT | What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? ...No, in all these things (what things, life) we are more than conquerors **through Him** who loved us.

BIG IDEA: When good isn't good enough, let God make it better.

A **secular worldview** (Secularism) defines life, and its conduct is based on secular, naturalistic considerations. Simply put, it is living life based on one's own authority.

Romans 1:21 & 28 NLT | Yes, they knew God, but they wouldn't worship Him as God or even give Him thanks. And they began to think up foolish ideas of what God was like. As a result, their minds became dark and confused...²⁸ Since they thought it foolish to acknowledge God, He abandoned them to their foolish thinking and let them do things that should never be done.

The four pillars of Satan's worldview/Secularism (You're the authority):

1. Feelings are your ultimate guide.

- Go with your gut.
- Be the authentic you.
- If it feels right.
- Trust your instinct.

2. Happiness is your highest goal.

- If it makes you happy.
- It made me happy; it must be right.
- Find your happy place.

3. Judgment is the ultimate sin. Don't judge anything/anyone for what they believe in as wrong.

4. God is the ultimate guess (You can't really know God).

A **biblical worldview** defines life and its conduct based on biblical, divine considerations. Simply put, it means living a life based on the authority of God.

The four pillars of God's Biblical worldview:

1. God has been revealed and proven. (Romans 1:1-4, John 1:1-14)
2. There is a righteousness to obtain. There is sin; it's painful, and it's to be overcome. (Matthew 5:48, Matthew 6:33, & Romans 3:21-25)
3. God's joy should be our highest goal. (Romans 5:1-2)
4. God's truth should guide our feelings instead of our feelings defining our truth. (Romans 12:1-2)

MOVING FROM GOOD ENOUGH TO GREAT (Romans 1-5)

1. Intentionally choose to live for God's purposes and His glory. (Romans 1:16-17)
2. Look to Jesus as the standard to live by. He gives us His goodness. (Romans 5:20-21)
3. Walk humbly, recognizing we all need His grace. (Romans 3:21-25)

Going deeper on your own: Read Romans chapter 1-5 four times and compare God's truth to worldly views. **NEXT STEPS:** Stop trying to define what's good enough. Receive God's truth and live from that grace.
