Crushing It | Raised to New Life

Romans 5:20-21 NIV | The law was brought in so that the trespass might increase. But where sin increased, grace increased all the more,²¹ so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

BIG IDEA: The freedom of life destroys the slavery of death.

Romans 6:1-7 NIV | What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase? ²By no means! We are those who have died to sin; how can we live in it any longer? ³Or don't you know that all of us who were baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into His death? ⁴We were therefore buried with Him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life. ⁵For if we have been united with Him in a death like His, we will certainly also be united with Him in a resurrection like His. ⁶For we know that our old self was crucified with Him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin – ⁷because anyone who has died has been set free from sin.

1. Grace compels us to live, think, speak, and act differently.
2. I am no longer who I was. Grace is continually making me new.

Romans 6:8-11 NIV | Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with Him. ⁹For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, He cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over Him. ¹⁰The death He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life He lives, He lives to God. ¹¹In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.

3. Life and grace have won for today and eternity.

Romans 6:21-23 NIV | What benefit did you reap at that time from the things you are now ashamed of? Those things result in death! ²²But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves of God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and the result is eternal life. ²³For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

4. Living for Christ is worth more than living for my old self.

NEXT STEP: What chains might be keeping you from embracing freedom? Allow the love of Christ to break those chains.

Going deeper on your own: Growth as a follower of Christ is an ongoing experience called sanctification. We are continually becoming more like Christ. The enemy (Satan) doesn't like that. He's going to push back on us, try to influence our thoughts, and tempt us to fall back into old ways of thinking and living. Read Ephesians 6:10-18 and talk through the armor of God. Craft a "battle plan" for guarding your thoughts and going on the offensive with your spiritual life.

1. Be expectant – Expect the enemy to attack. Expect God to be your defender and strength.
2. Identify negative thoughts and weak points – At the first sign of negative thinking or temptation, identify that thought and take it captive in the name of Christ.
3. Fight back – Memorize scripture verses that remind you of God's promise to be there with you and how we are called to think on holy and good things. Listen to worship music to help you focus on the Lord.
4. Replace and rebuild – Replace negative thoughts and temptations with what God says about you. You are a child of God and He has called you to faithfulness and strength. Live in that truth.
