Crushing It | Living in God's Love

Jeremiah 31:3 NLT | ...“I have loved you, my people, with an everlasting love. With unfailing love, I have drawn you to myself.”

Romans 8:39 NLT | No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

BIG IDEA: Living in and powered by His love is the only life worth living.

Romans 8:31-39 NLT | What shall we say about such wonderful things as these? If God is for us, who can ever be against us? ³²Since He did not spare even His own Son but gave Him up for us all, won't He also give us everything else? ³³Who dares accuse us whom God has chosen for His own? No one—for God Himself has given us right standing with Himself. ³⁴Who then will condemn us? No one—for Christ Jesus died for us and was raised to life for us, and He is sitting in the place of honor at God's right hand, pleading for us. ³⁵Can anything ever separate us from Christ's love? Does it mean He no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? ³⁶(As the Scriptures say, “For your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep.”) ³⁷No, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us.

³⁸ And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God’s love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither our fears for today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God’s love. ³⁹ No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

HOW TO LIVE A LIFE OF LOVE IN CHRIST

1. Remember, God is always for me. (vv. 31, 38 & 39)
2. Remember, God has made me right based on His character, not mine. (vv. 32-34)
3. Remember, faith in Christ means no matter what this life may bring, it will be overcome. (vv. 35-37)
4. Respond by intentionally choosing to love Him back.
Romans 10:10-11 NIV | For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess and are saved.
¹¹ As Scripture says, “Anyone who believes in Him will never be put to shame.”
5. Respond by intentionally choosing to share His love with someone else. (Romans 10:12-15 NIV)

Going deeper on your own: Take a moment to read Romans 8:31-39 slowly and out loud. Allow both your spirit and mind to absorb its truth. Answer the following questions: How would your life change if you knew God was always for you in every situation and circumstance? How would your life change if you knew that God loves you regardless of your shortcomings? How would your view towards life change if you knew that no matter what you might go through, God was with you and that victory would come? **NEXT STEPS:** Write down what it means to you that God loves you and will never forsake you. Find a friend, family member, or coworker and share this reflection with them. As you share, tell them how they can experience this unshakable joy and assurance in God’s love.
