## LIFE IN RHYTHM

**Ecclesiastes 3:11 NLT** | Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time...

**Isaiah 26:3 NLT** | You (God) will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you!

**BIG IDEA:** Trusting God with every part of our life ensures that no day is wasted and each moment becomes meaningful.

God's created Rhythms: Chronos (seasons and cycles) and Kairos (moments)

## THE RHYTHM OF LIFE

**Ecclesiastes 3:1-8 & 11 NLT** | For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven. <sup>2</sup>A time to be born and a time to die. A time to plant and a time to harvest. <sup>3</sup>A time to kill and a time to heal. A time to tear down and a time to build up. <sup>4</sup>A time to cry and a time to laugh. A time to grieve and a time to dance. <sup>5</sup>A time to scatter stones and a time to gather stones. A time to embrace and a time to turn away. <sup>6</sup>A time to search and a time to quit searching. A time to keep and a time to throw away. <sup>7</sup>A time to tear and a time to mend. A time to be quiet and a time to speak. <sup>8</sup>A time to love and a time to hate. A time for war and a time for peace... <sup>11</sup>Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time.

## HOW TO LIVE IN RHYTHM

### 1. Recognize the beauty of time (rhythms), how it's made, and who made it.

**Ecclesiastes 3:1 & 11 NLT** | For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven... Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time...

### 2. Seek out the Master Conductor and give Him the baton.

**Matthew 11:28-30 NIV** | Jesus said, "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest... For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

**James 1:5-6 NLT** | If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and He will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. <sup>6</sup>But when you ask Him, be sure that your faith is in God alone. Do not waver, for a person with divided loyalty is as unsettled as a wave of the sea that is blown and tossed by the wind.

**Proverbs 3:5-6 NLT** | Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. <sup>6</sup>Seek His will in all you do, and He will show you which path to take.

### 3. Join His orchestra (family) and enjoy the music with others.

**Psalms 133:1 NIV** | How good and pleasant it is when God's people live together in unity!

**Going deeper on your own:** Spend time in prayer, asking God to reveal what season you're currently in and how you can align yourself with His rhythm for this time. Then, read Ecclesiastes 3:1-8. Before diving into the passage, pray and invite the Holy Spirit to speak to your heart, revealing fresh insights and truths about the scripture.

**NEXT STEPS:** Remember: *"You will only live this day once."* Be intentional about putting something into it that God will look upon with joy tomorrow. Finally, commit to attending the next three Sundays and journey with us as we discover how to live in rhythm with God's seasons and moments.
