EMBRACE THE COLORS

Ecclesiastes 3:1 NLT | For everything there is a season...

Ecclesiastes 3:11 NLT | Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time...

BIG IDEA: Each season in life is beautiful and fulfilling when used for its designed purpose.

Chronos is Greek for seasons.

HOW TO LIVE IN RHYTHM WITH THE COLORS (SEASONS) OF LIFE

1. Understand, embrace, and honor the seasons God has given me.
(Ecclesiastes 3:1-11, Psalm 90:10 & 12)

Psalm 90:10 & 12 ESV | The years of our life are seventy, or even by reason of strength eighty; yet... they are soon gone, and we fly away.
... ¹² So, teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom.

THE FIVE KEY SEASONS OF LIFE

Childhood (0-12 years) - formative years

Adolescence (12-22 years) - discovery/development/equipping years

Young adulthood (22-45 years) - foundational and building years

Middle adulthood (45-65 years) - productive years

Latter adulthood (65+ years) - legacy/investment years

2. Recognize what belongs and what doesn't in each season.

(Ecclesiastes 3:1-11)

Ecclesiastes 3:11 NLT | Yet God has made everything beautiful for its own time...

3. With God's help, prepare appropriate guardrails for each season and celebrate them well. (Prov. 14:16, Eph. 5:15-19, Jer. 17:7-9, & Ja. 1:5)

Ephesians 5:15-17 NLT | So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. ¹⁶ Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. ¹⁷ Don't act thoughtlessly but understand what the Lord wants you to do.

4. Celebrate beginnings and endings well. (Ecclesiastes 3:1 & 11)

A key to enjoying the colors is intentional rituals.

Going deeper on your own: Review today's message notes and read each passage mentioned in the outline. Pastor Jay said, "'NO' is an answer from God too—it's also a complete sentence." Do you agree or disagree with this statement? How could embracing this perspective enhance your life's meaning, purpose, and fulfillment?

Pastor Jay also shared that every year, with God's help, he creates not only a to-do list but also a to-don't list. How might creating a to-don't list benefit you? What things in your life may God be calling you to let go of?

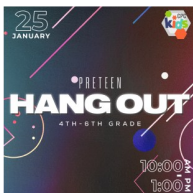
Baptism Opportunity
