## Embracing Kairos

**Ecclesiastes 3:1 NLT** | For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven.

**BIG IDEA:** Interruptions are inevitable; God wants to turn them into meaningful moments—It's time to let Him.

Kairos is Greek for moments.

### HOW TO EMBRACE THE MOMENTS (KAIROS)

Case Study: Luke 8:41–56

#### 1. Recognize moments for what they are.

**Ecclesiastes 3:1 NIV** | There is a time for everything...

God-Ordained Interruptions: Luke 8:43-44, Luke 19:3-5, & John 1:1-42

**Luke 8:43-44 NLT** | A woman in the crowd had suffered... Coming up behind Jesus...

Satan's Interruptions: Luke 8:41-42, 1 Peter 5:8, & David's failure in 2 Samuel 11-12

**Luke 8:41-42 NLT** | Then a man named Jairus, a leader of the local synagogue, came... pleading ... His only daughter, who was about twelve years old, was dying.

**2. Bring Jesus into the moment.** (Luke 8:41 & Luke 8:44)

**Luke 8:41 NLT** | ...Jairus... pleaded with Him (Jesus) to come home with him.

**3. See the person and the need.** (Luke 8:42 & Luke 8:45-48)

**Luke 8:42 NLT** | ...Jesus went with him...

**4. See the need and seek the answer.** (Luke 8:50)

**Luke 8:50 NLT** | ...“Don't be afraid. Just have faith, and she will be healed.”

**5. Be the bridge to the answer.** (Luke 8:48 & Mathew 5:16)

**Luke 8:48 NLT** | “Daughter,” he said to her, “your faith has made you well...”

**Going deeper on your own:** This week, read Luke 8:41-56 and reflect on how Jesus handled interruptions with grace and purpose. Review the key points and passages, such as Ecclesiastes 3:1-11 and Ephesians 5:15-17, and consider how to recognize moments for what they are, bring Jesus into them, and respond with faith and action. **NEXT STEPS:** Look back over the past week and write down one interruption you experienced, noting how you responded and whether it felt like an opportunity or an obstruction. Reflect on how God may have been working in that moment or what He might have been teaching you. Finally, share your story with a small group or trusted friend to encourage one another to see interruptions differently, and challenge yourself to approach future interruptions with curiosity and prayer, asking, “God, what are You doing in this moment, and how can I join You?”
